DESTINATION

When travelling abroad it's always great to find new and exciting destinations to explore. Here are a selection of our must-see attractions to discover when you visit the beautiful island St. Kitts.

- Ride the Sugar Train
Board the scenic railway, the last one in the West Indies. Built for sugar trade in the early 20th century, the double decker carriages now take sightseers on an 18 mile journey with complimentary rum punch and the sounds of the train's own choir.
- Brimstone Hill Fortress National Park
This UNESCO World Heritage Site stands 800ft high overlooking Sandy Point and is one of the island's top tourist attractions with historical, cultural and architectural significance. Dating back to the late 17th century, this well preserved fortress was designed by British engineers and maintained by African slaves and is one of the best preserved historical fortifications in the Americas.
- Fairview Great House
Step back in time and visit an 18th Century French Great House that has been authentically restored to its former glory with careful attention to historical detail. Enjoy a stroll in the gardens and take in the breathtaking panoramic surroundings. Not forgetting the chance to sample various St. Kitts rums or even take a cooking class.
- Zipline in the rainforest
Get your heart rate pumping and glide along the Caribbean's longest zipline. You won't be short of astonishing views as you soar through the lush, tropical rainforest. This adrenaline-fuelled experience allows you to reconnect with nature and perhaps catch a glimpse of green vervet monkeys, a truly unique and unforgettable adventure.
- Lime with the locals
If you're looking to kick back and relax day or night, limin' (the well known term in St. Kitts) is easy to do. The rustic beach bars of the peninsula and Frigate Bay are the favourite places to enjoy delicious food, soak up rum cocktails and enjoy DJs, karaoke or live music features.
